**PUBLIC SPEAKS:** Patricia Kirk re: Passed out wristbands. Discussed the Tree Ordinance and the Kresge lot; James Smith, Sr. re: Expressing the need for more police presence, Junction Tavern has been broken into 3 times recently and every time he calls police they tell him to tell the Mayor that "we need more cops." Also advising of flooding problems in his area. Further advising that the Sanitation Department throws the trash cans in the street every week after they empty them; Jason Scaglione re: Relaying that the drug activity in his area is out of control and asking for help; Robert Breazeal re: Problem with speeding on Fawcett Ct, Junction Ct NW and Wertz and the street lights and street signs are covered up by trees. Also expressing the need for street sweepers after fair; Amy Breazeal re: Tired of seeing the man who cleans up the neighborhood getting sited for minimal things when there is nothing being done about the crimes that occur in the neighborhood. Expressing problem with Section 8 houses and the criminals that live in them. Also relaying her fear to leave her house during "fair time" because of there are teens that fight in the streets and carry on while cops just stand there and watch. Also would like to see some trash cans put along the tree lines at fair time so people don't use the street for trash instead; Jan Schueler re: It is her opinion that this town needs an urban forester to educate the City about tree care; Kelly Scaglione re: Passed out flyer with issues in the neighborhood. Problem with curfew in her neighborhood, children under 10 play until all hours of the night. Also problems with unsecured vacant properties, public intoxication with no recourse from police; Cindy Hall re: Would like to work with City leaders in determining what to do with vacant Lehman Jr. High School; Michael Swintosky re: Would like to see a committee formed for renovating vacant Lehman Jr. High School; Jody Whalen re: Concerned about what will become of the vacant Lehman Jr. High School, would like to see it made a recreation center or a park but would not like to see it made low income housing; Lynda Tutle re: Would like to be involved in part of

the decision that is made with vacant Lehman Jr. High School, expressed concern that the building has been empty and being vandalized for too long; Larry Heckamen re: Relaying that he has witnessed Lehman being vandalized and by the time police arrive they are gone. He believes that something needs to be done quickly with school because there is going to be nothing left of the school. Also advises that if police ticket people \$100.00 for the noise ordinance perhaps they could hire more police officers with the money.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS: Majority Leader Casar re: Advising that the School Board is in complete control of Lehman Jr. High School, that Council has no say over what will become of the school; Development Director Torres re: Advising that Lehman is the under the jurisdiction of Canton City Schools, however there have been two companies (neither being low income housing) looking at the property; Thomas West re: Advising that Tuesday, July 29, 2008 at 6:00 PM there will be a meeting at Nimissilla Park regarding different issues; James Griffin re: Thanking speakers for coming and advising them that there will be a neighborhood clean up on Sunday, August 3, 2008 at 1:00 PM in Harter Heights; Safety Director Nesbitt re: Thanked citizens for coming to speak at Council and relayed his desire to have a meeting to discuss and address concerns.
