





RE: Legislation Request - Cromer Reservoir Improvement Project

Dear Madam President and Honorable Members:

Ordinance #106/2022 authorized the city to enter into a professional engineering agreement with Arcadis to develop construction plans and specifications for Cromer Reservoir Improvement Project. Cromer is a 15 million-gallon, buried, concrete water reservoir that was built circa 1920. This structure is essential for storage and regulating pressure within our distribution system. As a result of a structural analysis of the existing reservoir and a hydraulic analysis of the distribution system, the Cromer Reservoir has been identified as having human health related deficiencies along with structural degradation. It was determined to replace the existing reservoir with a new 7.5 million-gallon reservoir in the same location. The design of the project is being finalized, and we will be ready to proceed with bidding the construction contracts in spring 2025.

The current cost estimate for the project construction and construction oversight is approximately \$16,275,000.00. To fund the Project, the Water Department intends to apply for a Water Supply Revolving Loan Account with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA), through the Ohio Water Development Authority. The Project is eligible for a low interest loan with a 25-year term. Current interest rates are at 3.03%, but are subject to change. As is typical for these loan agreements, I will be submitting a second companion communication asking for the specific language OEPA desires for the loan, and will be appropriating the funds for the Project on a third communication after we receive the exact loan amount from OEPA.

Therefore, I hereby request legislation that does the following:

- 1. Authorizes the Mayor and/or Director of Public Service to advertise, receive bids, award and execute any and all contracts necessary for the Cromer Reservoir Improvement Project.
- 2. Authorizes the Mayor and/or Director of Public Service to execute a professional services contract for construction oversight services for this project.
- 3. Alternatively authorizes the Mayor and/or Director of Public Service to enter into any and all contracts needed for this project utilizing any procurement process authorized by law.
- 4. Authorizes and directs the Auditor to pay any and all moral obligations for contract change orders that are otherwise approved by the Board of Control pursuant to Canton

- 5. Authorizes the Auditor to receive all loan and revenue proceeds and track project expenses creating the 5242 Cromer Reservoir Improvement Project Fund.
- 6. Authorizes the Auditor to draw warrants upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.
- 7. Declares this ordinance to be an emergency measure.

This is the second separate and concurrent legislation requests for the above-named project. This second request is being made separately from the authorizing ordinance due to the fact the OEPA is looking for specific ordinance/resolution language for their loan approvals. As stated in the first communication, the Water Department intends to pay for this project through a Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA). This project's cost is currently estimated at \$16,275,000, but will be determined once the bids are opened this spring. Additional project details can be found in the first legislation request. Again, the WSRLA requires the government authority to pass specific legislation authorizing a loan/the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source using the exact language in the attached sample ordinance.

Therefore, I hereby request legislation that does the following:

- Authorizes the Mayor and/or Director of Public Service, on behalf of the city of Canton, to apply
 for a Water Supply Revolving Loan Account, sign all documents for and enter into a Water Supply
 Revolving Loan Agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and Ohio Water
 Development Authority for planning and/or construction of drinking water facilities on behalf of the
 city of Canton, Ohio.
- 2. Declares the dedicated source of the loan repayment will be the Water Department Enterprise Funds.
- 3. Declares this ordinance to be an emergency measure.



For the last several years, we have been able to prop up and fund multiple successful summer programs utilizing American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. ARPA funding is no longer available. As a result, we have included youth development as a focus within the recently passed comprehensive plan amendment. As previously discussed and presented, we have budgeted \$500,000.00 annually for summer youth programming out of the Comprehensive Plan Fund. Recently, the Department of Community Development completed an RFP for the expenditure of the funds. Attached, please see the recommended programs. Additionally, we are proposing two-year contracts in order to give agencies stability and the capacity for planning.

Therefore, I am hereby requesting legislation that does the following:

- 1. Authorizes the Mayor or Director of Public Service to enter into any and all contracts necessary in order to implement the 2025 Summer Youth Programs as attached.
- 2. Amends the final budget ordinance, as amended, by making the following supplemental appropriation:
