





The Water Department desires to replace approximately 600 feet of 4" waterline, 1,500 feet of 6" waterline, and 5,600 feet of 8" of waterline in the Broad Avenue Northwest Area. The Water Department advertised for qualifications from professional engineering firms, and by utilizing the qualification-based selection process as required by the Ohio Revised Code, have selected Verdantas, LLC. to perform the detailed design engineering at a total cost of \$110,000.00. The estimated cost of the construction and construction oversight of the project is approximately \$2.2 million, but the Water Department will be applying for OPWC grant and loan funding totaling \$1.5 million to help fund this project.

Therefore, I hereby request legislation that does the following:

- 1. Authorizes the Mayor and/or Director of Public Service to execute a professional services contract with Arcadis for design of the Broad Avenue Northwest Area Waterline Replacement Project.
- 2. Authorizes and directs the Auditor to pay any and all moral obligations for contract change orders that are otherwise approved by the Board of Control pursuant to Canton Codified Ordinance 105.14 within the established dollar amount thresholds for the above-named project.
- 3. Makes the following supplemental appropriation, amending the final budget ordinance as amended:

Dear Madam President and Honorable Members:

Recently City officials were presented with a presentation and proposal from Habitat for Humanity East Central Ohio (Habitat) whereas they are willing to add garages to homes built within the City of Canton beginning in 2026. Additionally, they are looking to expand their home rehab program. Given that New Housing Construction, Healthy Neighborhoods, Critical Home Repair, and Urban Design and Zoning are all components of the recently approved Comprehensive Plan Amendment, we are proposing moving forward with a three-year funding agreement with Habitat for this proposal utilizing Comprehensive Plan Funds for \$150,000,00 per year beginning in 2026. Habitat would use the funds to build garages with new builds within the City when the lot allows for it. Any leftover funds would then be put towards rehabs. We are requesting authorization now in order to give Habitat the opportunity to begin planning for 2026.

Therefore, I hereby request legislation that does the following:

- 1. Authorizes the Mayor and/or Director of Public Service to execute a three-year professional services/funding contract with Habitat for Humanity East Central Ohio in the amount of \$150,000.00 per year, \$450,000.00 total, for the purpose of garage construction and home rehab within the City of Canton.
- 2. Authorizes the Auditor to draw warrants upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper department authority.
- 3. Declares this ordinance to be an emergency measure.




